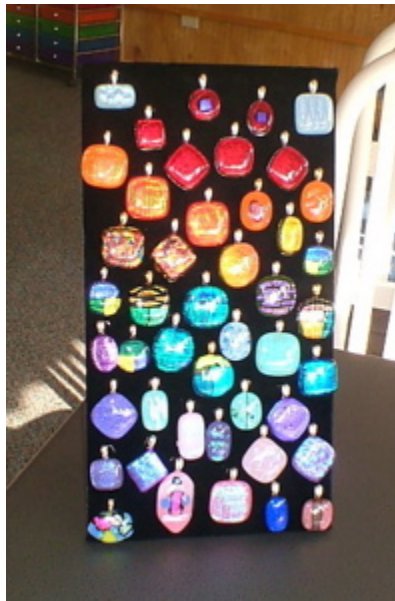

## class listing

Sat, Feb 27 (2 - 4:30 pm) **Glass Fusing:** Chris Gorman will teach you basic glass properties and lead you through creating beautiful fused glass earrings and pendants. \$55, includes your materials; \$10 deposit.



Tues, Mar 2 (6:30 - 9 pm) **Beading Basics:** Learn all the basics of making necklaces, bracelets and earrings in this fun class. You will learn two techniques: how to attach a clasp to a bracelet/necklace, and how to do the "hangman's noose" wire wrap technique for earrings. You will leave class with a finished pair of earrings and a bracelet! \$25 fee includes \$10 bead/finding allowance (additional supplies extra); \$10 deposit.

Weds, Mar 3 (11 am - 1:30 pm) **Soldering and Metal Forming:** Els Heber teaches soldering and will start you with a ring or pendant. Pick out a gemstone cabochon, or bring your own shell or beach glass. You will work with the torch, jewelers saw, hammers, files and polishing tools. \$55 for the class; small materials fee extra; \$10 deposit. Reservations required - this class is offered every other Wednesday.

Thurs, Mar 4 (2 - 4:30 pm) **Loom Work:** Pat Kort will teach this classic technique, and you'll be surprised how easy it is to create a beautiful bracelet! \$25 class fee + \$18 kit fee; \$10 deposit.

Thurs, March 4 (6:30 - 9 pm) **Needle Felting:** Patty Outtrim is a master in this field, and has created amazing felted sculpture using wool roving and a felting needle. We will create

a 3-D Fish in this class. Needle felting is such a versatile art form...take this class and learn from the best! \$35 class fee + \$12 kit fee; \$10 deposit.



Fridays, beginning April 3 (8 - 10 am) **Pottery - Slab Work for Beaders:** Hoping the weather will be kind to us, we'll start a 6 week session, working with white clay and making our own pendants, focal pieces, beads and bracelet segments. \$20 per session, we will take you through finishing, glazing and firing.

Sat, Mar 6 (2 - 4:30 pm) **Copper Creations:** We will use the torch to ball up the ends of copper wire pieces, change the color of copper sheet, and anneal it so we can create endless designs. Pea pods...picture frames...your imagination is the limit. Bring your own tools, bead stash and "found items," wear cotton clothes and closed-toed shoes! \$40, supplies included; \$10 deposit.

Tues, Mar 9 (6:30 - 9 pm) **Free-form Wire Wrap:** This class is for you if you've been wanting to use that odd shell you found on the beach last vacation...we'll take round, square and half-round wires and create artistic "cages" for your memento so it can be worn on a necklace. Bring your own wire-working tools (round nose, chain nose, flat nose pliers and flush wire cutter) or buy them here! \$25 + \$15 wire kit fee; \$10 deposit.

Thurs, Mar 11 (2 - 4:30 pm) **Cha-Cha Bracelet:** A classic, this bracelet becomes uniquely your own when you bring your own favorite beads to use on it. Each one is unique - a great gift idea! \$30 class fee, supplies extra; \$10 deposit.

Thurs, Mar 11 (6:30 - 9 pm) **PMC (Precious Metal Clay):** Come and take a lesson in how to use this marvelous medium...recycled silver particles in a clay base...you work it somewhat like clay, then put it in a kiln. All the clay burns away and leaves pure silver! \$95 class fee includes a 28 gram package of clay, instruction, firing and finishing; \$50 deposit.

Sat, Mar 13 (2 - 4:30 pm) **Silver Cross Pendant:** Yvonne will teach you basic soldering technique as you create your own sterling silver cross, just in time for Easter giving. You will work with the torch, sterling silver sheet, filing and polishing. \$55 class fee plus a small materials fee; \$10 deposit.

Tues, Mar 16 (6:30 - 9 pm) **Polymer Clay:** Peggy Ward will teach this class using skinner blends, wire and image transfer to create very artsy pendants and pins. You will need your own pasta machine (Atlas recommended!), Premo clay in translucent, white, beige, black,

and 2 primary colors of your choice (fuchsia, cadmium yellow or blue). Bring your own wire working tools too, if you have them. \$35 class fee; \$10 deposit.

Weds, Mar 17 (11 am - 1:30 pm) **Soldering and Metal Forming:** Els Heber teaches soldering and will start you with a ring or pendant. Pick out a gemstone cabochon, or bring your own shell or beach glass. You will work with the torch, jewelers saw, hammers, files and polishing tools. \$55 for the class; small materials fee extra; \$10 deposit. Reservations required - this class is offered every other Wednesday.

Thurs, March 18 (2 - 4:30 pm) **Serpentine Bracelet:** Pat Kort has designed this eye-catching bracelet that is also fun and fast to make. A good beginner bead-weaving class! \$30 class fee (supplies extra); \$10 deposit.



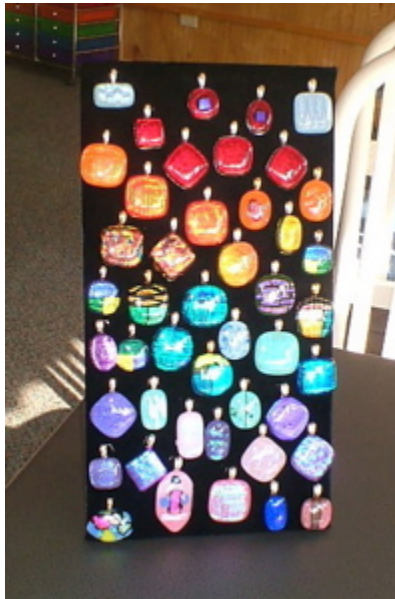
Sat, Mar 20 (2 - 4:30 pm) **Enameling:** Els Heber will teach this class in basic enameling, using copper shapes and powdered glasses. You will leave with a finished pendant or two, and can continue classes with Els to learn all the enameling techniques: cloisonne, sgraffito, basse taille, etc. \$55 class fee, small materials fee extra; \$10 deposit.

Tues, Mar 23 (6:30 - 9 pm) **Beaded Cross:** Peggy Ward will teach you how to make this very pretty cross, in time for Easter giving. Bring your own bead stash, and your wire working tools (round nose, chain nose, flat nose pliers and flush wire cutter). \$30 class fee + \$8 kit fee; \$10 deposit.

Thurs, Mar 25 (2 - 4:30 pm) **Seed Bead with Nancy:** From Herringbone to Peyote to Brick and Square Stitches, Nancy can multi-task and take you through the steps to master any of the basic bead weaving stitches. \$25 class fee; \$10 deposit - let us know ahead of time what project you want to tackle.

Thurs, Mar 25 (6:30 - 9 pm) **Viking Knit:** Learn to weave wire the way the Vikings did for armor...but embellish your wrist instead! A very easy and soothing weaving technique, come to this class to learn how to set up your own loom and make gorgeous heirloom jewelry. \$25 class fee + \$15 kit; \$10 deposit.

Sat, March 27 (2 - 4:30 pm) **Glass Fusing:** Chris Gorman is back to teach this class, which includes basic glass cutting instruction, stencil work with dichroic glass, and more. \$55, includes supplies; \$10 deposit.



Tues, Mar 30 (6:30 - 9 pm) **Cold Shop Silver-Smithing:** A cool class for anyone who wants to get a little more creative with beading. You will learn to hammer silver blanks and heavy gauge wire to make unique focal pieces and findings. \$35 includes supplies; \$10 deposit.

Weds, Mar 31 (11 am - 1:30 pm) **Soldering and Metal Forming:** Els Heber teaches soldering and will start you with a ring or pendant. Pick out a gemstone cabochon, or bring your own shell or beach glass. You will work with the torch, jewelers saw, hammers, files and polishing tools. \$55 for the class; small materials fee extra; \$10 deposit.
